The Booth Museum Photography Guild (BPG) invites your photography club to participate in the 2011 ShootOut, **OCTOBER 1, 2011** at the Booth Museum in Cartersville, Georgia, 7:30 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Participating clubs will compete to see who can create, process and submit the best images in each of five categories – all in one day! After learning of the five categories that morning, photographers from each club will disperse into the community to capture the finest photos possible. They will then gather in their club's designated meeting room to download, select, process and submit their photos to their club's team captain. Members of each club will submit their best photos in each of the five categories. The club team captain will submit the final choices to the ShootOut judges by 2:00. An awards ceremony will include cash, prizes and ribbons to individuals for the best top 4 images in each category. Each club's cumulative points will be totaled to also determine the winning clubs. Goody bags and great door prizes will be awarded throughout the day.

While the judges are deliberating that afternoon, participants will be able to visit photography vendors, sponsors, get their camera sensors cleaned, attend informative presentations, tour the Booth Museum, and talk photography with fellow participants...or rest! Lunch will be available by pre-order. Cash bar available.

The Booth Museum's facilities offer an excellent venue for this day's event. The photography potential in and around the city of Cartersville is limitless. And the typically fine weather the first of October will lend this ShootOut to a North Georgia day of fun, photography, camaraderie and competition with a slate of fine judges.

Cost: \$300 per club; each club may determine how that fee will be collected.

Eligibility: Open to North Georgia Camera Club Council member photography clubs. Individuals may not register; registration must be through a club. Small clubs may join together as one club for the ShootOut. High school camera clubs must have an adult team organizer and may participate for \$10 per student.
